

Modern Slavery Policy

Introduction

This Modern Slavery Policy is in accordance with the requirements outlined in paragraphs 103 and 104 of the relevant legislation or guidance, commonly referred to as RATO (Regulation against Trafficking and Exploitation). It sets out our organization's commitment to combating modern slavery, including forced labour and human trafficking, within our operations and supply chains.

Policy Statement

Definition of Modern Slavery:

In line with RATO's definitions, we define modern slavery as any form of forced labor, human trafficking, or exploitation that deprives individuals of their freedom, dignity, and human rights for the purpose of exploitation or economic gain.
